

## **Baltimore Youth Train With Man City Pros**

*Blast Teams Up With Manchester City Football Club To Provide Soccer Clinics*

Baltimore, Md. -- The Baltimore Blast has joined forces with Manchester City Football Club of the English Premier League to bring a series of youth soccer clinics to Baltimore. The clinics will take place July 30 and July 31 in conjunction with Manchester City's game against Inter Milan at M&T Bank Stadium July 31.

The first of the three clinics will take place July 30 from 9 a.m. to noon at the soccer facility at Towson University. The first session will be geared toward Under-14 boy's teams from throughout the Baltimore metropolitan area.

The second clinic will begin at 2 p.m. July 30 and will feature local Under-14 girl's teams. The final clinic in the series will take place July 31, less than 12 hours before Manchester City kicks off against Inter Milan in a friendly match at 8 p.m. at M&T Bank Stadium. The Saturday-morning clinic is for Under-18 teams and will run from 9 a.m. to noon.

All three of the filled-to-capacity Manchester City clinics will be held on the campus of Towson University and are free to the youth soccer players. In addition to the training from MCFC coaches, the youth players will receive a T-shirt, courtesy of MCFC and Umbro. The Baltimore Blast invited youth players from rec. councils all over the Baltimore area to participate in the free sessions with MCFC.

The Blast is currently hosting youth summer soccer camps all over the Baltimore area until the end of August.
