## **Terenzo Bozzone(NZL), Samantha Warriner(NZL) Win 2010 Eagleman Ironman 70.3 Triathlon**

**Columbia, MD** –On Sunday, June 13, in Cambridge, Maryland, triathletes from around the world competed in the Eagleman Ironman 70.3 Triathlon, a qualifier for the Ford Ironman World Championship Kona and the Foster Grant Ironman World Championship 70.3 Clearwater. The race includes a 1.2 mile swim in the Choptank River, 56 mile bike through the Blackwater National Wildlife Refuge, and a 13.1 mile run beginning and ending at Great Marsh Park.

New Zealand's **Terenzo Bozzone** (25), a 5-time World Champion, defended his 2009 Eagleman Champion title winning the race during the run. Bozzone was 4 minutes behind Yoder at the start of the run, but caught up mid-way through and led **James Cotter** (28-Austin TX), and **Andrew Yoder** (21-Columbia PA) to the finish. **Samantha Warriner** (39), a 2004 and 2008 Olympian from New Zealand, led the women from the start to win the 2010 Eagleman title over **Sam McGlone** (31-Canada), an Ironman 70.3 World Champion and 2004 Olympian, and **Michellie Jones** (41-AUS), the most decorated female triathlete with 200+ major wins. The 2010 Eagleman Ironman was sponsored by SUBARU, Spinervals and GEICO Powersports.

Named the winner of the Best Race Support category in the March 2009 issue of *Triathlete Magazine*, the event draws approximately 2,400 participants, 3,000 spectators, and 900+ volunteers each year. The race is organized and directed by the Columbia Triathlon Association (CTA), a 501(c)-(3) Corporation, established by President and Race Director, Robert Vigorito. CTA also directs **The Columbia Triathlon**, Centennial Park, MD, the **Celebration Sprint Triathlon**, Centennial Park, MD (June 27, 2010), the **Tri Columbia Kidz Triathlon**, Columbia, MD (July 25, 2010), the **AFLAC Iron Girl Columbia Triathlon**, Centennial Park, MD (August 22, 2010), and the **ChesapeakeMan Ultra Triathlon Endurance Festival**, Cambridge, MD (September 23 and 25, 2010).
