



## **GAME FACT SHEET – JULY 31, 2010**

### **ABOUT MANCHESTER CITY**

- Manchester City finished fifth in Barclays Premier League (England) this season. They were led by Carlos Tevez, who is in his first season with Man City after playing for rival Manchester United the past two seasons. Tevez, who is Argentinean, scored 29 goals for the club this season (23 in the Premier League) and added seven assists. The team is managed by Roberto Mancini.
- Manchester City has won two English league titles, and has been runner-up three times. They captured league honors during the 1936-37 and the 1967-68 seasons, and won the European Cup in 1970.
- Manchester City had 10 players selected to the 2010 World Cup preliminary rosters. Some of the more notable players include Tevez (Argentina), Robinho (Brazil), Nigel de Jong (Netherlands), Kolo Toure (Ivory Coast) and Gareth Barry (England).

### **ABOUT INTER MILAN**

- With a 2-0 win over Bayern Munich in the UEFA Championship Game on May 22, Inter Milan became the first Italian team to win their domestic league (Italia Serie A), domestic cup (Coppa Italia) and the European Championship (UEFA). The victory marks the third time in history that Inter Milan has won the trophy (1964 and 1965) and earns club.
- Throughout their history, Inter Milan has been one of the most dominant clubs in the game of soccer. They've won 17 Serie A titles (including the past five) and were runners-up 13 times. Additionally, they have won the Coppa Italia (Italy Cup) six times, including this season. They were led in 2010 by Alberto Diego Milito, who scored 30 goals (22 in Serie A). Samuel Eto'o - who is known for his superior play while playing for the Cameroon National Team - contributed 15 goals (12 in Serie A) and six assists.
- Inter Milan has had three FIFA World Players of the Year in its history - Ronaldo (1997 and 2002) and Lothar Matthaus (1991). They also had eight players selected to the 2010 World Cup preliminary rosters, including Milito (Argentina), Eto'o (Cameroon), Julio Cesar (Brazil) and Lucio (Brazil). Additionally, Inter Milan is managed by José Mourinho, one of the top managers in the game who was twice recognized as the "World's Best Football Manager" by the International Federation of Football History and Statistics (IFFHS).

### **ABOUT INTERNATIONAL SOCCER IN BALTIMORE**

- The game on July 31, 2010 will mark the second straight summer that Baltimore and M&T Bank Stadium are playing host to an international soccer game. Last summer, Chelsea played AC Milan as part of the World Football Challenge. The game was sold out as over 70,000 people filled M&T Bank Stadium, including nearly 12,000 tickets purchased by fans who travelled nearly four hours to Baltimore for the event.
- The game supported nearly 300 Maryland jobs and augmented local business revenues by approximately \$20 million. Additionally, over \$1.5 million in combined State and local taxes were generated as a result of the game.
